AgVOCATOR™ SCHOLARSHIP

Farm Credit of Northwest Florida is offering six \$1,500 scholarships to high school seniors within its chartered territory. Two students in each region (list below) will receive a scholarship. Preference will be given to students pursuing a career in Agriculture, Forestry, Horticulture, or Veterinary Medicine.

Farm Credit of Northwest Florida is a member-owned financial cooperative headquartered in Marianna, Florida. Serving 18 counties throughout the Florida Panhandle, Farm Credit offers highly competitive credit to meet the financing needs of farmers, agribusinesses, and rural landowners and homeowners. At Farm Credit, we are AgVocators, meaning that we actively support the well-being of agriculture and rural America. Every day, we are *Helping Rural America Grow*®, not only food and fibers, but also stronger rural communities. Our desire, through these scholarships, is to encourage new AgVocators to use their talents to create better communities where they live.

Guidelines and Eligibility:

Scholarships are awarded to applicants based on academic aptitude, vocational promise, personal attributes, and leadership qualities. Additionally, applicants must:

- Be a high school senior planning on attending college and in good academic standing.
- Complete a scholarship application.
- Provide an official copy of their transcript; a resume of work history, activities, honors, and volunteer efforts; an essay on how the applicant plans to use their major in his or her chosen career path; and a signed letter of recommendation with the application.
- Live within the Association's chartered territory of the following Florida counties: Eastern Region (Franklin, Gadsden, Jefferson, Leon, Liberty, Madison, Taylor, and Wakulla); Central Region (Bay, Calhoun, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, and Washington); or Western Region (Escambia, Okaloosa, Santa Rosa, and Walton).
- Linear family members of employees and directors of Farm Credit of Northwest Florida are not eligible to apply.
- The scholarship is open to private, public and home school students.
- The scholarship will be disbursed to the winners' College/University upon proof of enrollment for the Fall 2019 semester.

To be considered for the 2019 Farm Credit of Northwest Florida Scholarship, a completed application (including all requested information and required signatures) must be **received** by February 11, 2019 by 5 p.m. CST/6 p.m. EST. Prepare your materials and scan them into a single document in the below order. Each of the items are required and must be **received** by Farm Credit of Northwest Florida by **February 11, 2019** at 5 p.m. CST/6 p.m. EST.

- Completed application.
- Copy of official transcript.
- Resume of work history, activities, honors, and volunteer efforts.
(two page maximum, typed, 10 point font, one-sided, single spaced, ½ inch margins max)
- Essay on how the applicant plans to use their major in his/her chosen career path.
(Limited to 1 page only, typed, 12 point font, double spaced)
- Submit a signed letter of recommendation with the completed application.(Maximum of two)
(Recommendations may be written by guidance counselor, high school teacher, or community leader and should represent the applicants attributes and provide evidence of unusual or remarkably distinctive qualities.)
- Live within the Association's chartered territory.
Chartered Territory includes the following Florida counties; please check the region your county falls under.
 - Eastern Region (Franklin, Gadsden, Jefferson, Leon, Liberty, Madison, Taylor, and Wakulla)
 - Central Region (Bay, Calhoun, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, and Washington)
 - Western Region (Escambia, Okaloosa, Santa Rosa, and Walton)
